

ABSENTEE VOTING

While the KIDS VOTING program prefers that all students go to the actual polls to experience the voting process and begin to establish a good voting habit, we realize that this is not always possible. Because KIDS VOTING strives to replicate the adult election for students, the following policies are in place to accommodate students who cannot go to the polls on Elections Day or who would like to vote early.

1. Student must be a “registered” voter.

2. Once registered, the student may vote absentee for any reason, but student may then not vote again at the polls on Election Day.
3. Have students who want to vote absentee fill out the form below (or send it home to have their parents/guardians fill it out) and return it to the KIDS VOTING office by Wednesday, **October 28.**
4. Form is also available at the KIDS VOTING office.
5. Upon receipt of the absentee application, the KIDS VOTING office will send a ballot to student at student’s school.
